2	All heavy equipment is lifted by two or more persons - notably the piano.	1
3	Equipment is strength tested for Peter's weight	2

Further Recommended Precautions

Scoring System

	Likelihood	Severity	Scoring = likelihood * severity
1 =	Highly unlikely	Minor cut or bump	
2 =	Unlikely	Minor injury	1 - 5 = low
3 =	Even Chance	Medium injury - needing hospital treatment	6 - 11 = medium
4 =	Likely	Major injury requiring hospital stayover	12+ = high
5 =	Very likely/certain	Disablement or death
